


# Year 10

## Face to Face Sessions



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
- Next academic year is crucial to our Year 10 students and we want to support them as much as possible.
- The safety of every individual in our academy takes precedence.
- “Face to Face” sessions will be very focused and are designed to supplement on-line learning.
- In the interests of health and safety, On-line learning will remain the predominate mode of education during the Summer Term.



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
## We will keep our community safe by:

- Year 10 will be split into two 'Home Groups'. These will be called **Team Indigo** and **Team Teal**. **In the first step to recovery, the two Home Groups will not be on the academy site at the same time.**
- Each Home Group will be divided into class groups.
- Class groups will consist of a maximum of 7 students to aid social distancing. There will be a maximum of 3 class groups on site on any given day (approximately 21 students).
- To start with, each class group will be in the academy **once per fortnight** (eg. Monday) and will receive an important tutorial in English, Maths, Science and their Humanity subject (History or Geography). This may be increased at a later date but will only happen when it is definitely safe to do so.
- All lessons will take place in the Achieve Block. Excess furniture has been removed from teaching rooms in order to support with social distancing and cleaning.




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- Students will remain in their ‘Home Room’ (single classroom), with their own desk and equipment pack. A seating plan will be in place. To control the spread of infection, the pack will also remain in their allocated Home Room and cannot be taken home.
- The academy day has been shortened to four 45 minute sessions, with one 15 minute break. Students will have access to a supervised outside space during their Break Time.
- Arrival, departure and Break times will be staggered for the three class groups. Students will be met by a Vice Principal who, with other Duty Staff, will supervise them entering and exiting the academy site.
- Students will remain in their Home Room throughout the day, with teachers travelling to them. All areas of the academy will be regularly cleaned throughout the academy day and teaching rooms will be deep cleaned after use. There will be a minimum of a 7 day “gap” between rooms being re-used.



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- To avoid unnecessary movement around the academy, students will be provided with snacks and a packed lunch, which will be delivered to their Home Room. Please do not send students with food and drink. You should contact Mrs J Spurgeon with any special dietary requirements.
- The main corridor, and other areas regularly used by staff and students, will have Duty Team and will be clearly marked to aid social distancing. Access to the student toilets will also be strictly controlled, with a maximum of two students utilising the facilities at any one time.
- To avoid the spread of infection, students will have to wash their hands regularly. All teaching rooms will be well ventilated with tissues and alcohol gel easily accessible. The use of air conditioning units will not be permitted.
- The Academy Behaviour for Learning Policy has been updated to reflect the need to socially distance. This will be sent to all parents by the end of this week with our updated Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy. Please discuss these with your son/daughter before they return to the academy.



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## You can support the academy by:

- Face coverings should not be worn as, if not used correctly, these can increase the likelihood of infection spreading.
- Regular washing of clothes is recommended and for this reason we do not expect students to wear uniform. However, they should be dressed sensibly for a school environment.
- It is strongly suggested that your son/daughter does not use public transport unless you have no other option. In which case, please make sure that your son/daughter understands the importance of following the social distancing guidance. Students can use their School Bus Pass on all First Bus Services during this difficult time.
- Ideally students will walk or cycle to school. If you drop off or collect your son/daughter, we ask that only one adult does this and that you do not get out of your car. Unfortunately it is not possible to have visitors on site at this time. Please call or email the academy with any problems.
- Do not send your son/daughter to school if they are unwell. Please report absence in the usual way.



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# Emergency Childcare Facility

In the interests of Health and Safety, the academy's Emergency Childcare Facility will continue to operate in a separate part of the academy.


